



FRENOTOMY POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Call our office if

- 1) Fever is greater than 102.
- 2) Bleeding occurs and will not stop with applying pressure.
- 3) Surgical area becomes red, swollen, warm to touch, or drains pus.
- 4) Patient vomits more than twice in a 24-hour period.
- 5) Patient becomes listless, hard to arouse.

Follow your surgeon's instructions regarding

- 1) Diet as tolerated, unless instructed otherwise.
- 2) Drink plenty of fluids.
- 3) If instructed, massage the wound twice daily for two weeks.

Pain Management

- 1) Alternate Children's Tylenol with Children's Motrin as needed.
